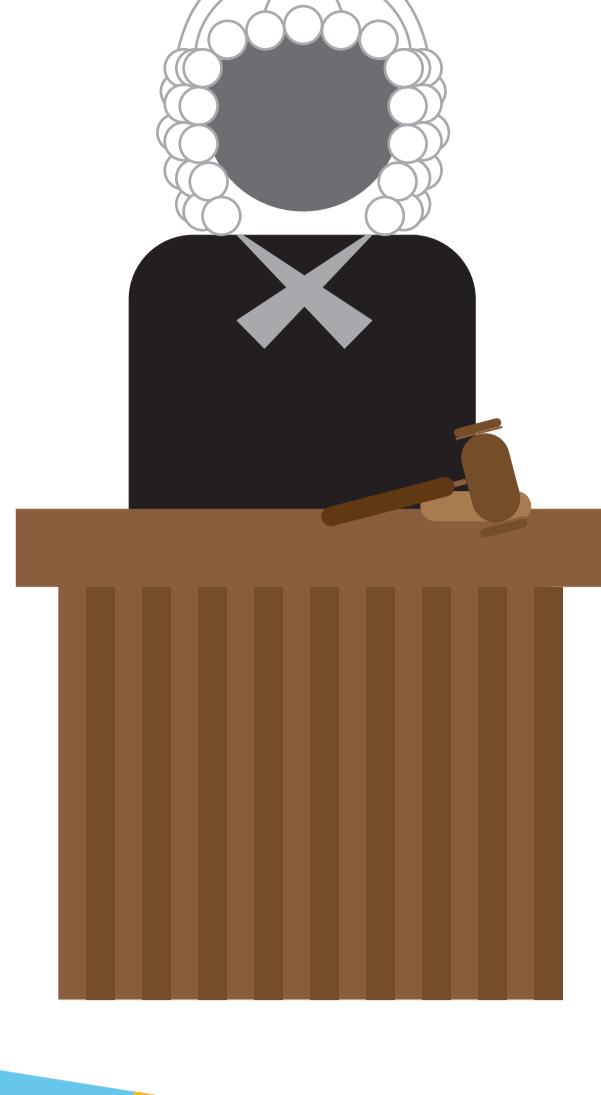


THE CORPORATE MANSLAUGHTER ACT (AND HOW IT AFFECTS YOU)

When the CORPORATE MANSLAUGHTER AND CORPORATE HOMICIDE ACT 2007

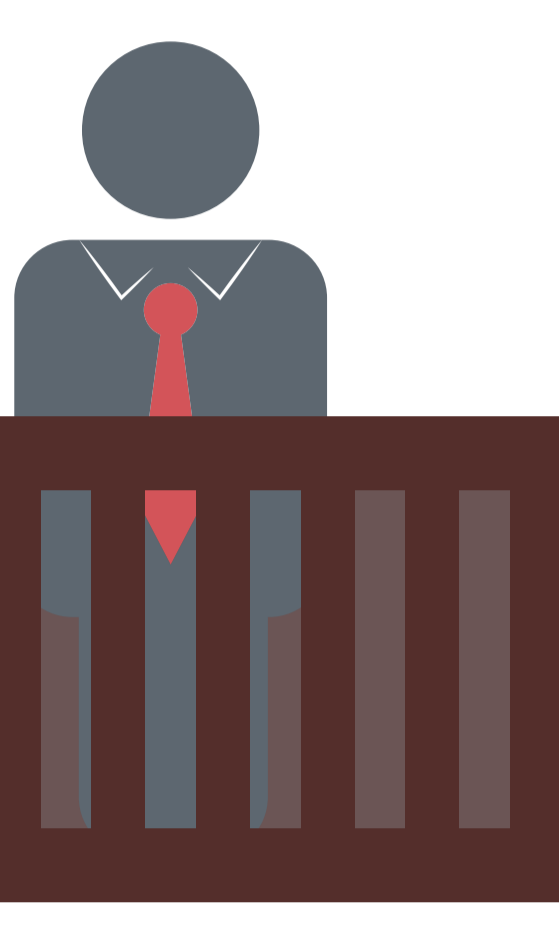
was introduced, it made it far easier to prosecute both private companies and public sector organisations where gross negligence leads to the death of an employee.

Under the legislation, management failings that lead to an employee's death could result in:

FINES OF UP TO 10% OF ANNUAL TURNOVER

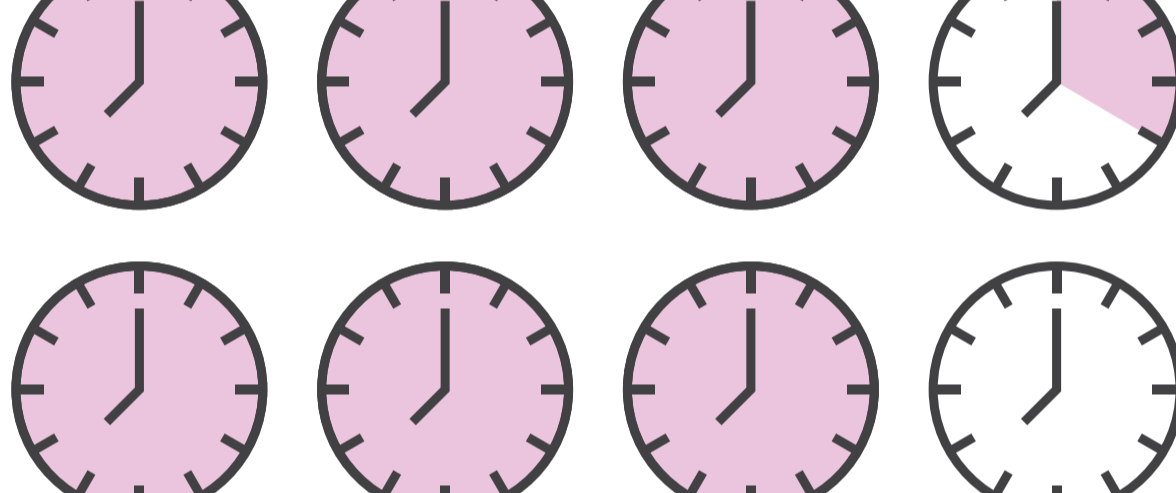

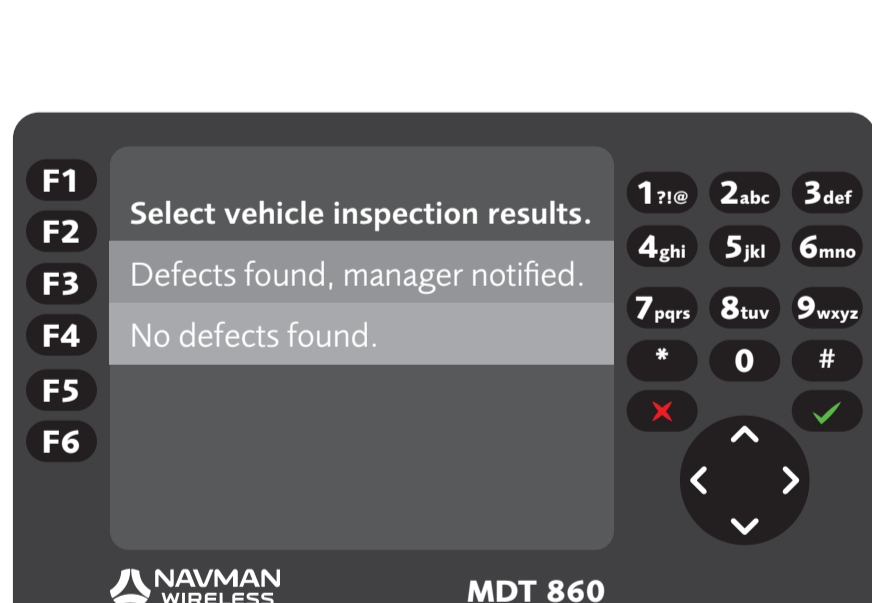
